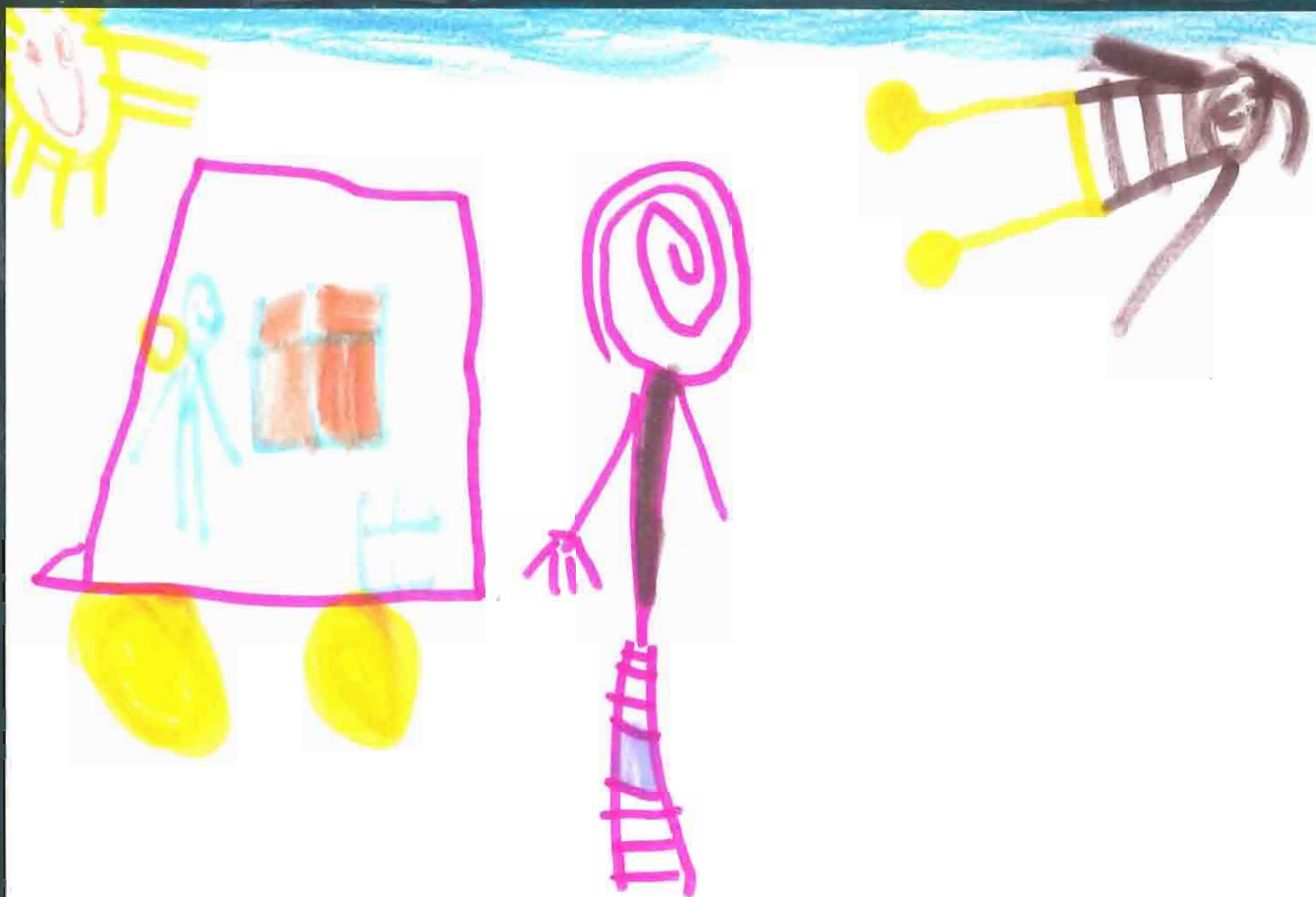
One day he got hurt.
